




DIY Binocular Instructions



1. Print, color, and cutPrint out the activity and color it in. Cut out binocular pieces along the dotted line.



2. Wrap tubes and tape
Wrap each tube with the cover
and secure with tape. Take the
outer wrap and place it over both
tubes and tape everything in
place.



3. Attach string

Punch a hole on opposite side of each tube. Cut a piece of string around 2 feet long and tie each end on either side.


