

Measure the hoses.




Make a cardboard fire truck.




Practice writing a letter to a firefighter.






Cut out the items at the bottom of the page. Then paste them under "Hot" or "Not hot" where they belong.









Color the firefighter. Then cut and paste the words from the next page (or write them in) to label the picture.








Cut out the ruler. Then measure the length of each hose and write the number in the box.











Color and cut out the pieces. Then glue them to a tissue box, shoe box, or similar to make a fire truck.
