









What is Lunar New Year?




Meet Jamie, age 4

Jamie celebrates Lunar New Year with his family. His favorite parts about the holiday are eating lots of sweets and wearing shiny red clothes.




Rosie and Jack are putting up red lanterns to welcome joy and good fortune into the home!






Robin and Harvey are eating delicious dumplings, a traditional food served during Lunar New Year!






Chinese Lantern

These lanterns are used to decorate the outside of homes and shops during Lunar New Year. They are traditionally red and yellow, and symbolize good fortune in the new year.




Instructions



1. Color and cut

Color in the design and cut out the lantern, handle and signs along the dotted lines.



2. Assemble lantern

Fold along fold lines, then glue outside lantern piece onto the inside piece. Glue ends together.



3. Add handle and sign

Glue on the handle at the top and your chosen zodiac animal sign on the front.
